Our goal is to help children and families cope with and adjust to hospitalization, diagnosis and treatment. A variety of interventions are used to address the needs and concerns of the patients and allow them to gain a sense of mastery and control in this highly stressful situation. We often use toys, games and crafts to help provide therapeutic interventions for the patients.

- All items must be latex-free.
- Gently used books, DVD's, music CD's, Playstation II, X-Box and Game Cube games can be donated.
- We ask all donors to respect the beliefs of our patients by not donating religious items.
